**Title: Value Based Care and Telehealth**

**Abstract:**

The 2 objectives of this presentation are to: (1) discuss the tenets of value-based care and (2) describe the importance of telehealth in the era of value based purchasing. With changes in governmental reimbursement of health care (with the Affordable Care Act), hospital-based and external health care reform and cost repositioning are important leadership functions that will affect how we deliver healthcare in the future.
